This form allows students to grant third parties, including parents, access to their educational records maintained by Stetson University College of Law. The Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act of 1974 (Buckley Amendment) prohibits access to, or release of, educational records or personally identifiable information contained in such records (other than directory information) without written consent of the student, with certain regulatory exceptions.
