

Awarding Diplomas

The College of Law will award diplomas three times each academic year: at the conclusion of the fall semester, at the conclusion of the spring semester, and at the conclusion of the oncampus summer session. Absent extraordinary circumstances, as determined by the Dean or Associate Dean for Academic Affairs, to receive a diploma, a student must have completed all graduation requirements by the date the Registrar establishes for faculty to submit grades for graduating seniors. In addition, absent extraordinary circumstances, the student must not have any pending honor code, conduct code, or criminal charges.
