

Credits Taken at the Tampa Law Center

- 1. Part-time J.D. students may take up to 45 total credit hours at the Tampa Law Center.
- 2. Full-time J.D. students and students in the International Law LL.M. program may take up to 15 total credit hours at the Tampa Law Center.
- 3. A part-time J.D. student who converts to full-time status may not take more than 37 credit hours at the Tampa Law Center. If a part-time J.D. student converts after completing 37 or more credit hours at the Tampa Law Center, the student may not take more than 45 total credit hours at the Tampa Law Center.

If a course is taught on alternative days at each of the Gulfport Campus and Tampa Law Center, the credits allocated to the course will be divided between Gulfport and Tampa based on the percentage of the course taught in each location. Credits will be rounded to the nearest .5 when allocated between the campus. Thus, if a 3-credit course is evenly divided between Gulfport and Tampa each week, a student will take 1.5 Gulfport credits and 1.5 Tampa credits. The division of Gulfport and Tampa credits will not be recorded on a student's transcript.
