**Conversion Between Part-Time and Full-Time J.D. Programs
(For J.D. Students who entered before Fall 2015)**

Students may apply to convert one time between the full-time and part-time programs in any semester after the student has attempted 28 credit hours. However, students may not convert from part-time to full-time status while on academic probation.

The Associate Dean for Academic Affairs determines whether to allow a student to convert from one program to another. Factors that the Associate Dean for Academic Affairs may consider in determining whether a student may convert from the part-time program to the full-time program include the student's cumulative grade point average; the trend in the student's semester averages; whether the student will be working and, if so, how many hours the student will work; the student's other commitments, such as co-curricular and extra-curricular activities; and other factors indicative of the student's ability to succeed academically as a full-time student.

Students who convert to the full-time program are required to comply with policies regarding limitation on working.

Approved by the faculty on October 15, 2008. This policy is effective beginning with students entering in the Fall of 2009.
