

Academic Advising

Faculty serve as academic advisors to Stetson students. The assignment of advisors to new students is based on the student's area of academic interest. The Discovery Program (<http://catalog.stetson.edu/undergraduate/discovery-program/>) provides support to students who have not declared a major. All faculty advisors help assess the student's interests and goals and provide counseling for course selection. Formal advising sessions are scheduled prior to registration for each new term, and advisors are also available for counseling throughout the academic year. Students may change advisors or declare majors or minors by filling out a request form in the Dean's Office of the appropriate College or School. While the faculty advisor assists each student in planning a course of study leading to graduation, the student himself or herself is responsible for meeting all stated degree requirements.
